

A Beginners Guide to Photo Showing:

What is a Photo Show?

Photo Show is a way of showing Model horses. You simply send in pictures you have taken of your model horse to the show holder/judges and they are judged just like a real life horse show. Each picture is judged on its realism. The most commonly used type of film is 35mm. Each model must have a name, breed, sex and age and must be appropriately placed in each class in which it is being show. (i.e. a warm blood would not be suitable in a western class).

The best way to display your horses' information for the photo show is to write it on the back of the photo of the horse. Information, which has to be included, is:

Name of Horse: (For Example: Lonesome Glory)

Breed: (For Example: Thoroughbred)

Sex: (For Example: Gelding)

Age: (For Example: 11 years old)

Class: # (For Example: #9- Thoroughbred Class)

Owners Name & Address: (For Example: Miss M. Mop, 4 Town Lane, Bath,)

When you send your pictures in, you should include a Stamped Address envelope so your photos can be returned to you.

So how can I enter?

1) Firstly, decide on which classes you would like to enter. Also decide which of your Breyer models you would like to enter in each class. Tip: Try to pick models that are in a good condition and that would look good in front of the camera.

2) Get Camera Happy! Find a camera and get snapping! Tip: Photograph your model with a background. You don't want to send in a picture of your model and you can see your kitchen radiator in the background! Not sure of the right background? Simply take your model outside and get snapping. Tip: Make sure your model is wearing the right tack if entering a performance class. (i.e. If entering a English class, your model should be wearing English Tack.)

3) After you have developed the pictures, send them into the show holder. Remember to include a SAE so your pictures can be returned to you. You should write on the back on each photo with the models information. (See above). Also remember to include the appropriate entry fee. Also make a date of when the photo show is being judged.

4) After the Photo show has been judged, your photos will be sent back
